

Home Nursery Agreement



The nursery will:	Parents will:	Children will:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare the nursery site and undertake a thorough health and safety risk assessment prior to the return of the children • Put in place protective measures to reduce risks in agreement with the trust • Have regular, stringent cleaning procedures in place • Take appropriate measures to keep children and staff safe whilst carrying out first aid or nappy changing. • Organise the staff and children into 'bubbles' with a maximum of 15 children to reduce the possibility of contact between different groups of children and adults • Remove any resources that cannot be thoroughly cleaned such as soft toys • Ensure that the same staff are with the children for at least 2 weeks • Provide a range of educational opportunities for all children, both in school and at home • Provide nurture and emotional support to aid the transition back to school • Ensure that there is a designated safeguarding lead on the school site at all times to support children, staff and parents • Endeavour to provide a meal in the form of a packed lunch for all children in receipt of universal free school meals or free school meals • Provide a (paid) packed lunch for children staying all day on request • Continue to update parents with any changes to guidance 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare your child to return to school by reassuring them that familiar staff will be there to support them although nursery may look different. • Adhere to our new one -way system at drop off and pick up times, leave your child at the door and have one consistent person to drop off and collect where possible • Support the 'drop and go' system and not stay or gather on the school site. If your child needs extra support we will provide it • Support the additional behaviour expectations and understand that your child's place may be reviewed should they not cooperate with nursery expectations around hand washing and sanitising and you may be asked to collect them • Agree to collect your child immediately should they show any symptoms of Coronavirus and follow testing guidelines where applicable • Only contact the school by email or phone • Ensure your child is wearing clean, comfortable clothes each day that are suitable for outdoor learning and shoes they can fasten themselves • Provide a full change of clothes in a named carrier bag to be left on your child's peg • Ensure your child does not bring any items to school such as toys • Send packed lunches in a disposable bag • Provide your child with their own individual water bottle on a daily basis- cleaned and refilled • Understand that some children may struggle to settle. Staff will support them as usual and will send photos/call to reassure you that your child has settled 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow school instructions on hygiene, such as hand washing and sanitising with staff support • Stay in their assigned 'bubble' group in the allocated areas both in the classrooms and outside on the playground with staff support • Follow age appropriate rules in the behaviour policy set out to support the safety of themselves and others with staff encouragement • Engage with the learning set for them in nursery and at home with adult support
